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## Photographic Competition for the 2019 Calendar

### Rules and Entry Form

The Society will once again be holding a photographic competition to determine the pictures for the 2019 calendar. The following rules will apply for this competition:-

1. Entries shall be restricted to KHS members
2. Entries can be either digital photograph submitted on a flash disk, CD or photo quality printer paper, or a standard 6" x 4" photographic print, or a photographic transparency slide. (Note: Digital images should be taken in the high resolution mode and contain at least one megabyte of data).
3. The entry can be either one photograph or several, but should not exceed 12, of which one, or more than one, maybe used.
4. The photograph must not be marked with the name of the entrant.
5. On receipt of the entry, the Committee will allocate an entrant number, which will then be used on the slide, photograph or CD, so that the judging group are not aware of the entrant's name.
6. The subject shall be one of the following:-
  - a. A close up of a flower showing the complete flower and its style of growth including some foliage.
  - b. A spray of flowers and their foliage
  - c. A flowering or foliage plant
  - d. THE DESK CALENDAR ....good pictures of gardens can be difficult to produce, so the judges will now also look at photographs of an attractive flowering tree or group of trees, be sure to include the whole tree/s in an attractive setting, flowering shrubs, or an unusual flowering garden feature, but please exclude unattractive walls and fences. There has been a request from the judges for more trees and garden scenes this year please.
7. All photographs must bear the common name (if there is one) and botanical name of the flower/plant.
8. A team comprising professional photographers, horticulturists and gardeners, will judge the entries.
9. Entries should be delivered to Kenya Horticultural Society Main office, now at East African Wildlife Offices on Riara Road (behind the Junction), or EMS to P.O. Box 868, Sarit Centre, Nairobi 00606 attn. Desmond Maganga.

**The closing date for entries will be 15th May 2018.**

11. The names of the winning photographers will be given credit on the printed calendar.
12. All photographs will be returned to the entrant if a self addressed and stamped envelope is provided.
